

Assessor & IQA Qualifications

LEVEL 3 & 4 QUALIFICATIONS

NOCN Level 3 Award in Assessing Competence in the Work Environment



This qualification is for assessors who assess occupational competence in an individual's work environment, e.g. work placements at employer's premises.

NOCN Level 3 Award in Assessing Vocationally Related Achievement



This qualification is for assessors who assess vocational skills, knowledge and understanding in environments other than the work environment, e.g. a workshop, classroom or other training environment.

The purpose of these qualifications is to confirm occupational competence and/ or 'licence to practice'.

These qualifications replace the Assessor Award (A1 and A2, formerly D32 and D33) and require candidates to demonstrate competence in a variety of assessment methods such as observation of performance, examining products of work, questioning and discussion with the learner.

Entry requirements

No formal qualifications are required for the level 3 Assessor Awards, but candidates will need access to a minimum of two learners who are studying an assessment based qualification.

NOCN Level 4 Award in the Internal Quality Assurance of Assessment Processes and Practice

Course delivery

This course is intended for those who maintain the quality of assessment from within an organisation or assessment centre. It replaces the Internal Verifier (V1) Award, formerly D34 and includes:

- **how to assess knowledge and understanding of the principles and practices that underpin the internal quality assurance of assessment**
- **how to assess a candidate's performance in assuring the quality of assessment and**
- **how to assess performance in leading the work of a team responsible for the internal quality assurance within an organisation or assessment centre.**

Entry requirements

Participants will need to be involved in the assessment and verification processes at their place of work and are required to quality assure at least two Assessors.
